

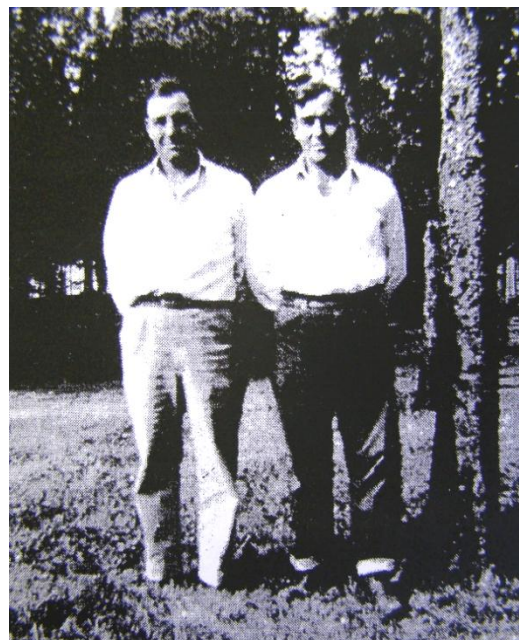
Claude Eslick

“We were healthy in those days so we didn’t need doctors,” we sometimes hear old timers say laughingly. But once in awhile there was a gruesome accident, when a doctor close by would have been a godsend. One day a bit flew off a saw and lodged in Claude Eslick’s cheek. The nearest doctor was thirty-five miles away. What agony he and his parents and others suffered until he was finally taken to a Denver hospital.
