

7V SLASH RANCH Owners: Amos Horn Redwood Fisher Toots Cherrington

Location:

600 acres of property on Stillwater Creek, off Hwy. 34 up County Road 42, which Redwood Fisher purchased from a federal land bank. It had been owned in part by Tupper and Huddler. A fence at the creek divides the 7V Slash from the adjacent Slash J Slash.

A pasture belonging to Jackie Boyd is found off County Rd. 41 just below (east) of 7V Slash.

General Ranch Information:

- * Redwood first moved to Middle Park in @1928, and worked as a summer RMNP ranger. Soon was ranching full-time, cattle, horses, hay on father's land (?) Red and Sara had a summer home in Grand Lake. It's still there, the large house on the river next to the Rapids Lodge.
- * Red bought this land from Amos Horn in about 1930.
- * The film crew of Dangerous Ground built a "hideout" structure on a hill on Toots Cherrington property (see Circle H Corral). When they left, they gave it to her brother Woody as a playhouse. The wood was later used as paneling in Toots' house.
