

Grand Central Hotel

Or the Nickerson House

This hotel was built and opened by Mr. Winslow Nickerson and his wife Lillian in 1880. The east end of the hotel housed Grand Lake's first school during the winter of 1881-82.

From the Prospector of May 17, 1883: "Crecelius and Miner are pushing the work on Mrs. Nickerson's new dining room. The two buildings will be connected by a piazza which will add greatly to their appearance." Mrs. Nickerson died in 1884 and Dr. J.N.R. Smith and family occupied the house. It later became an Ice Cream Parlor.

In 1919 the Grand Central Hotel and Restaurant became the Corner Cupboard, under the ownership and able management of Mr. and Mrs. Henry W. Rhone.
