

## **Mable Eslick**

*From The Middle Park Times November 8, 1918*

Mabel Eslick died at the family residence in Grand Lake, Colorado, Saturday November 2, aged eighteen years, three months and twenty five days. Mabel Eslick was born at Idaho Springs, Colorado July 10, 1900. She came to Grand Lake at the age of four years and lived there since that time. She was the youngest of two sisters and is survived by her parents Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Eslick, one sister Bessie of Oak Creek, Colorado, and four brothers, the twins Clyde and Claude, Clarence and Loren. She was the granddaughter of P. H. Smith, one of the pioneer residents of Grand Lake. She was a model young woman in her life, an obedient and faithful daughter in the home as elsewhere. She was kind and affectionate to everyone she had to do with. She will be greatly missed by her many friends. She was the third victim of the influenza in the same family, two of her uncles have died in the past three weeks. The funeral service was held at Grand Lake, Monday, November 4. Services were conducted by the Reverend W. R. Hodges, using a scripture lesson, Revelations, 21<sup>st</sup> chapter, the first 20 verses, and the text of 3<sup>rd</sup> Corinthians, 13<sup>th</sup> chapter and 11<sup>th</sup> verse. There was a beautiful tribute of flowers. The family offers their heartfelt thanks to those who lent helping hands and hearts in their sad hour of bereavement.
