George Bunte

George was born in Hanover, Germany in 1860.

He owned many properties in the area. He and his brothers homesteaded ranches near Granby in the 1880's. He also owned the Lemmon Lodge property on the shores of Grand Lake with 21 lots. He had the main cabin built for himself by Henry Schnoor a local builder at the time. He continued to run the three homesteads as the Bunte Brothers Ranches until they were sold around 1910. George sold his main cabin and the rest of the Lemmon Lodge property that he developed in 1921. He then retired to Denver and died in 1926 after a long illness.
